**Belle Grove Plantation** was an 18th-century grain and livestock farm, which, in its prime encompassed about 7500 acres of land. The unique limestone house was completed in 1797 for Major Isaac Hite and his wife Nelly, sister of future President James Madison. The house has remained virtually unchanged through the years, offering visitors an experience of the life and times of the people who lived there. During the Civil War, it was at the center of the decisive **Battle of Cedar Creek**. Imagine waking up one morning and finding the Civil War in your backyard. Learn what happened that morning. A wonderful tour full of variety.
